Learning objectives	<p>To promote independent learning</p> <p>To give pupils various topic areas that they may want to explore—to increase awareness of global interdependency</p> <p>Promotion of cross curricular links within the school</p> <p>Peer and self assessment as a tool for student engagement and development of an investigative approach to working within Science.</p>
Teacher objectives	<p>To let go!</p> <p>To enable development of teaching skills- teacher to teacher peer assessment</p> <p>To assess how effective student focused learning is in raising achievement and levels of student involvement.</p> <p>To develop teacher confidence and competence in providing opportunities for students to determine their own points for development in project work.</p>

5minutes	Starter: introduction to our project- recap.
40 Minutes	<p>The pupils decided who was working on which area in the last lesson. This lesson the pupils were working on their presentations, organising resources and developing a plan for the prep time. I was available for guidance where necessary, to give advice about web-sites available, occasionally had to vet certain points.</p>
15 minutes	<p>At the end of the lesson 3 groups were confident in presenting their plans for the presentation</p> <p>This enabled the groups to assess the standard of the work so far, enable them to adjust any problem areas in their plans and to sort out what each member of the group were doing.</p>
